Our Programme



Medical Emergency Support

Child Help Foundation is committed to Saving the Lives of Children suffering from Congenital Anomalies and Non-communicable diseases like Cancer, Congenital Heart Diseases, Organ Failure, and Respiratory Diseases. We ensure that children with serious illness do not have to suffer in the dawn of their lives. Child Help Foundation reaches out and provides the best of treatment in our partner hospitals. Our efforts have saved 632 critically ill children across India.

Education



Child Help Foundation aspires to provide Quality Education that is Inclusive. The aim is to Empower Children to become Informed, Competent and Compassionate thus making them Global Citizens. Child Help Foundation has made a positive impact in the lives of 1,04,670 Children.



Clean Water and Sanitation

Improving Sanitation is a key priority of the Government of India. It has introduced a flagship programme called Swachh Bharat Abhiyan. Child Help Foundation has been at the forefront of promoting Dignity and Safety by facilitating the provision of clean and separate toilets for both girls and boys. Child Help Foundation has constructed 72 Toilets and WASH facilities in schools across India, directly benefitting 7,200 children.

Menstrual Hygiene Programme

Child Help Foundation curbs the myths and misconceptions regarding the menstrual cycle through advocacy and spreads the correct message of hygiene among communities. This ensures that adolescent girls have the right answers to all their intimate questions and thus they do not have to suffer the consequences of poor menstrual hygiene. CHF regularly facilitates the distribution of free sanitary napkins to school students under its Menstrual Hygiene Management Programme. This programme has benefited 3,800 girls and another 12,500 beneficiaries would be added very soon.

Gender Equality



Poverty, Discrimination and Exploitation keeps Girls out of School. We work at the grassroots level promoting Girl Child Education and are a part of the National Flagship Programme - "BETI BACHO, BETI PADHAO." Our education programme is designed to create equal opportunities for both girls and boys, thus creating a better balance of power between genders.



Zero Hunger

Child Help Foundations aim is to ensure that no child dies of Starvation and we are fighting malnutrition in the most affected tribal pockets of Palghar district. Our centres in Jawhar have catered to the nutritional needs of 212 malnourished children, and we plan to implement this project in other areas.

Humanitarian relief and Rehabilitation



Child Help Foundation has been at the forefront in responding to Natural Calamities. During the extensive devastation after the floods in Uttarakhand, Assam, Bihar, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Jammu and Kashmir and Odisha, our teams reached out to provide immediate relief to 13,000 affected families.
