**Integrated Village Cluster Development Programme:**

The Cluster Development Programme aims to create opportunities for the underprivileged in order to facilitate a well built foundation. The programme has created new innovative precedents in the realm of nurturing talent. It facilitates integrated growth of villages and a holistic development of underprivileged communities. It also aims to transform identified cluster of villages into vibrant "Model Villages" and promotes these active, diverse and prosperous rural model villages as an easily replicable model for the development of other rural communities precisely on six major development areas: social, economic, environment, health, education and skill development.

**Nurturing Talent Programme:**

To uplift underprivileged students, DLF Foundation runs a variety of talent nurturing programmes such as awarding of merit scholarships and nurturing talent of rural children through a variety of interventions for marginalised students from Class 1 to Class XII and subsequently supports them to pursue their graduate and post-graduate studies. The project helps to identify, support and nurture talent of deserving children by giving them enough opportunities and space to realise their potential to the fullest. This programme aims to enable the selected scholars to access quality education in appropriate schools and ensures overall development through personality development, mentoring, handholding and counseling. Over 600 scholarships have been given across six states recently.

**Skill Development Programme:**

DLF Foundation believes that skilling and linking training with employment is the key for India's growth. With the aim to skill and provide jobs to one million youth across the country in the areas of IT, Construction, Electronics, Retail, Customer Services and Hospitality, the Foundation is establishing Skill Training Centres across the country. Assured Employment linkages have been built into the model to ensure its success. The Centres are well equipped with working laboratories to ensure focus on practical skills. The Skill Programme is being implemented in a manner where skill sector experts have also been enlisted and are involved in running the centres. A total of 30 DLF Life skills centres have been established so far across the states.

**Other Initiatives:**

**Food Bank:** In addition to its Flagship Programmes, the DLF Foundation has also continued to work on its initiatives like the establishment of Food Bank, launching of many Labour Welfare initiatives and undertaking many environmental initiatives.

**Veterinary Hospital:** India's first State-of-the-art private veterinary hospital (CGS) in Gurgaon with ultra modern facilities like laser surgery, ultra sonic testing and modern lab facilities for animal care was established in Gurgaon.

**Rural schools:** DLF Foundation has also helped in establishing 30 rural schools in Haryana, UP and Punjab in partnership with Bharti Foundation. Situated in remote areas, these rural schools educate 12,500 children every year with a focus on the girl child.



**SBM Schools:** The SBM Senior Secondary School, a Government Aided School in Delhi has been established with the best of infrastructure. Over 800 students studying at the school hail from low income families residing in and around DLF projects.
