Vision:

To enrich the lives of the communities by empowering them to develop and execute sustainable livelihood models. Urvi Ashok Piramal Foundation (UAPF) is the corporate social responsibility (CSR) wing of “Ashok Piramal Group”.

Our Verticals:

Education:

We believe that good education is the foundation to good citizenship. Quality education and simplifying the concepts is the focus of our supplementary education “Pathshala” programme. The employees children and children from the communities benefit from this programme.

Scholarship:

Financial support is given annually to children of the employee's to pursue higher education. Every year over 50 children get the benefit of this programme and this support has enabled many students to pursue further studies.

Creche:

At the companies construction sites, the contractors have set up labour colonies. UAPF, has extended its support by way of running creches for the children of construction workers. Along with basic education, health, hygiene and nutrition is the focus and through the children, parents are reached and are educated on health and nutrition. About 500 children take the benefit of creche in three locations.



Health:

Good health ensures good citizenship and keeping this into focus, UAPF runs digitalized Mobile Health Units (MHU) in various locations such as Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra.

These vans ensure that basic health services are provided at the door step. The vans reach out is in tribal areas, rural and semi urban areas. Basic health checkup, diagnostic investigations covering HB, sugar and BP is checked and medicines at a very nominal rate are provided to the patients. MHU covers about 25 villages and 45,460 people have benefitted through the services offered by MHU in the last financial year. The Foundation has 8 such vans of which 3 are in Rajasthan, 2 at Nagpur, 1 Pench, Madhya Pradesh, 1 Karjat and 1 at Nasik.



“Aayushi” General and Maternity Hospital:

It is a 25 bedded hospital catering to Maternity and general health services, situated at Jhunjhunu District, Rajasthan. The hospital is equipped with operation theatre, pathological laboratory and nursing staff. Regular health camps like cancer screening, gynecological camp and HB test with medicines are provided at a nominal cost during the camp. The Foundation plans to start Ophthalmology, orthopedic and other specialties in the coming years.



Site Clinic:

There are five site clinics that run twice a week and it has a MBBS/MD physician consultation. These clinics take care of basic health issues faced by workers and their families at factory premises and at construction sites. Regularly general and specific health camps are also organized through the site clinics and in all 7163 patients benefitted through the site clinic last year.



Livelihood:

In Maharashtra, we have partnered with an NGO to conduct the popular MS-CIT computer course. We have trained 100 students for computer course, 788 for sewing and other hobby courses. The foundation is now affiliated with Rajasthan Skill and Livelihood Development Corporation to conduct various sustainable skill development courses. Along with skill training, the emphasis is on grooming the youth to become good entrepreneur. The goal is to provide end to end facilitation to individuals who want to initiate micro entrepreneurial ventures.



Environment & Village Development Work:

The Conservation Wildlands Trust, another initiative under the CSR, has established E-base at Turia Gate of Pench, Madhya Pradesh. This is a first of its kind in India and second in the world, it runs entirely on clean energy through solar power.

The Foundation conducted Satellite survey in partnership with Art of Living (AOL) at Nagpur, to work on soil & water conservation measures by construction of check dams in selected villages. The water conservation has been completed successfully in a village at Nagpur which will directly benefit about 2000 people. Village development work such as water conservation, solar lamps, sanitation and tree plantations are carried out at a few villages in Jhunjhunu District, Rajasthan.
