### Business and Social Vision of the organization:

Engineers India Limited (EIL) is one of the leading design and engineering organizations in South Asia. Established in 1965, EIL provides engineering consultancy and EPC (Engineering, Procurement & Construction) services principally focused on the oil & gas and petrochemical industries. EIL strongly believes in the reconciliation of social, economic and environmental demands – the three pillars of sustainability. At EIL, the sustainability mandate is about operating its business in a manner that is responsible and transparent to all its stakeholders and to the society at large.

EIL's CSR policy is strongly integrated into the company's business vision, where the company is committed for operating its core business in a socially responsible way, by taking into consideration the wider interests of the community and the environment, with a vision of promoting sustainable development.

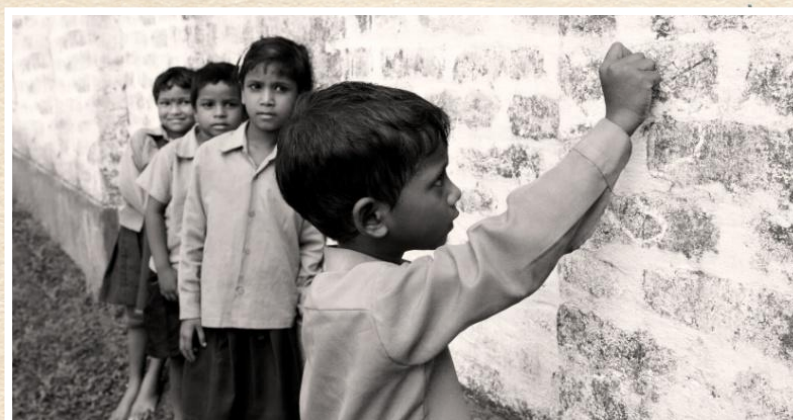
The CSR program in EIL aims to assist socially and economically weaker segments of society, building stronger communities and creating a sustainable environment. The CSR mission of EIL have been guided by two elemental ideations, namely, the philosophy of enhancing the educational, health and environmental conditions of the society and towards supplementing/supporting the ongoing and planned initiatives of the local, state or central government with projects / programs being located in and around its work places which includes project sites, regional & branch offices and Head office. The major areas of intervention for CSR projects in EIL that has benefitted the communities at large are education, healthcare, drinking water & sanitation, community development, environment protection & sustainability, rural electrification, women empowerment and upliftment of underprivileged.

### Major Projects

CSR initiatives of EIL entail sustained efforts to raise the quality of life of people from the deprived sections of society. EIL with its CSR initiative focuses on community development and inclusive growth.

### Education:

EIL's contribution towards promoting education aims at creating conducive environment for overall development of the local community. One of the major projects undertaken by EIL in the field of education is Ekal Vidyalaya i.e. One Teacher One School in association with Bharat Lok Shiksha Parishad (BLSPP) where, 100 Ekal Vidyalayas were adopted in the rural villages of Dibrugarh in Assam. The Ekal Vidyalayas provide free, non formal education to children in the age group of 6 to 14 years belonging to poor community and are taught by a trained local youth selected by the Gram Samiti. More than 3000 children benefitted from this project, leading to improved general awareness amongst the local population on education, hygiene, sanitation and cleanliness.



### Healthcare:

EIL has been facilitating preventive & curative healthcare facilities to the poor and needy patients belonging to the underprivileged sections of society. To further its commitment, EIL in association of District Collector & Magistrate of East Godavari, Kakinada had facilitated the construction of 2nd and 3rd floor of existing Millennium Block of Government General Hospital (GGH), Kakinada. This involved construction of Super Speciality

Block of Pediatrics & Plastic Surgery on the 2nd floor and the block of Urology & Neurology on the 3rd floor of the Government General Hospital (GGH), Kakinada.

EIL has also provided Cancer Detection Van to carry out cancer screening and detection amongst poor and needy population of Delhi and NCR where there are no cancer screening hospitals.



### Drinking water and Sanitation:

Safe and clean drinking water is essential for the health and wellbeing of all people. One of the major projects completed under this initiative is the construction of Reverse Osmosis (RO) water treatment plant for augmenting potable water supply in the Kancheepuram District of Tamil Nadu. Approximately 1,000 people benefitted from this project with increased access to safe and drinking water.



### Rural Electrification:

EIL has been working towards addressing the needs of electrification in rural India by undertaking Solar Electrification projects in the rural regions of India. Under this initiative, EIL in association with Kargil Renewable Energy Development Agency (KREDA) installed and commissioned two units of 40 KwP Solar Photo Voltaic power plants on community participation basis at Pipcha & Pigmo in Zanskar subdivision of Kargil District in Jammu & Kashmir.



### Environment Protection:

In an effort to enhance awareness amongst school children and local population on environmental protection and sustainability, a social outreach program was conducted in association with Pathfinders in the Trans Himalayas region.



### Women Empowerment:

Guntur District of Andhra Pradesh is a major textile hub of India. Many rural artisans in the state are involved in weaving and sewing, but due to lack of formal training, these rural artisans find it difficult to compete in the mainstream market. Realizing the same, EIL provided 40 sewing machines to ADDRESS Society for providing training to the rural artisans of the state. ADDRESS Society (Association of Dispassionate Development Renaissance Embodied Social Service) is an NGO that has trained and educated many poor villagers for better life, especially poor women, orphans and widows.



### Upliftment of the underprivileged:

EIL had undertaken various CSR Projects for the upliftment of the underprivileged people which includes facilitating education of 550 blind students and children of blind parents by providing study materials; distributed adult diapers and items for the elderly & destitute persons of Old Age Home of Saint Hardyal Educational and Orphans Welfare Society at Delhi and provided two hearing screening machines to Child Care Centre, Kochi to carry out the screening of new born infants to identify hearing loss and provide remedial treatment.
