SANT NIRANKARI CHARITABLE FOUNDATION (SNCF)

An Overview

In every community, there is work to be done. In every nation, there are wounds to be healed. And in every heart there exists the power to do it. This is the basic tenet of the Nirankari philosophy. Throughout the history of the world there have been individuals and organisations that have taken up the mantle of being that helping hand, enabling people to rise above the abyss of poverty and live better lives. One such organization is the Sant Nirankari Charitable Foundation (SNCF) which believes in Service with humility.

The year was 1929 and the world was changing. Spearheading that change was the dynamic voluntary wing of the Nirankari Mission, better known as SNCF, which was established in its present form in 2010. With a history that goes back almost a century, SNCF has stood by people through the test of time, following steadfastly its principles of healing, enriching and empowering the society.

Our contribution to the society has already found recognition across the world. The Economic and Social Wing of the United Nations Organization (UNO) has granted Special Consultative Status to the Sant Nirankari Mission. The Hon. President of India and the Hon. Prime Minister of India, have both applauded our sincere contributions to the society. The Mission was awarded 'Queen's Golden Jubilee Award' for Voluntary Service in U.K in June 2015.

HEAL :

Healthcare is a pressing need today. In the fast paced life of modern civilization we are faced with pressing physiological and psychological needs, and SNCF has been working for decades in the field of healthcare, making it more accessible to the common man. Subsidized healthcare through Dispensaries and Pathology labs run at our various centres and Free Health Checkup Camps etc. are some such initiatives.

At Agra, we are running the Sundrani Charitable Eye Hospital where thousands of patients have been operated upon. We have also been regularly conducting Eye Checkup Camps pan India where free cataract operations are arranged for the needy. In Mumbai such camps are being held every month.



We have also been conducting Chiropractic Camps bi-annually where a team of doctors and experts from all over the world have successfully treated thousands of patients, especially from economically disadvantaged backgrounds.

Over the last three decades, our initiatives in the domain of Blood Donation have been based on the thought that 'Blood should flow in veins and not in drains'. With 9,00,000 pints of blood already donated, we continue to hold such camps on a monthly basis. We have also received awards from the Govt. of India and recognition from the World Health Organization (WHO) and almost every national and international forum on blood donation, including the renowned Indian Red Cross Society.

ENRICH :

Education is the foundation of any society and if that education is rooted in ethics then that learning takes the form of an enhanced sense of social responsibility that is inculcated among its students. Today SNCF is running as many as 18 Primary and Senior Secondary Schools across the country as well as a Senior Secondary School in Nepal, providing ethics based education with a holistic approach to learning. In addition, the Vocational Centers run by the Foundation provide skill-based training to youngsters to elevate their prospects of employability. SNCF also runs a state-of-the-art post graduate college, established in 1975, on the outskirts of New Delhi, India benefitting the local communities of 60 villages around it.



Scholarships are awarded to meritorious students from Schools and also from Colleges, assisting them to achieve their goals. Value Education Sessions are being conducted regularly at our centres on a weekly basis instilling human values in our youth and children.

EMPOWER :

SNCF works towards generating opportunities that leads to self-sustainability of individuals and has been moving steadfastly to make our planet more sustainable. Cleanliness Drives and Tree Plantation Drives are a part of this endeavour. In one of the drives in August 2015, 1,00,000 saplings were planted by approximately 30,000 volunteers in Tilpath Valley, Delhi. We have held monthly Cleanliness Drives at public places such as parks, river banks and hospitals. In one such drive at 50 major railway stations of India, over 3,00,000 man hours were contributed in 2016.

We have been contributing regularly to disaster relief in both man-made and natural calamities. Be it the not so distant Tsunami that hit Asia, or the earthquake that had hit Gujarat or Nepal, the floods of Uttarakhand, or the Cyclone in Tamil Nadu, SNCF volunteers have always contributed to the best of their ability by ferrying the trapped to safer locales, helping to remove debris, rebuilding homes and providing basic necessities such as medicines, food, clothes etc. We also help in their rehabilitation by providing monetary and voluntary assistance.

Many Villages in India still need attention, care and development. SNCF has adopted three villages of Haryana – PanchiGujran in Sonipat District

and Patti Kalyana and BhodwalMazri in Panipat District, providing healthcare, education, sanitation etc. for overall development.



Women, especially in India, need to be empowered to face the challenges of the world today, and SNCF is very active on this front too. Besides Vocational Training for professions such as Tailoring, Beautician, etc. and Self defence courses are also provided.

Our upcoming projects include a 1200+ bed Super Specialty Hospital named Nirankari Health City, where quality health services shall be provided on a charitable basis. SNCF also looks forward to extend these efforts and serve the society by developing a Post Graduate Institute of Medical Research and a Medical College which aims at making specialized healthcare education affordable and accessible to the common man.

We also plan to introduce Dispensaries on Wheels, while expanding our fleet of existing ambulances, dispensaries etc. . Plans are afoot to adopt many more villages in the near future.

SNCF follows the vision of His Holiness Satguru Baba Hardev Singh ji and His teachings of Oneness and Humanness have been guiding us in all our activities. Our strength lies in the spiritual patronage of Her Holiness Satguru Mata Sawinder Hardev Ji, who is carrying forward His divine vision. The thousands of highly motivated and dedicated volunteers spread all across the globe allow us to contribute consistently, meaningfully and selflessly to the society.
