Holistic Education Support Programme

There is an urgent need to introduce the concept of holistic education in schools. While academics has to be stressed upon, overall development of children is equally important to ensure that they have the right life-skills to tackle the challenges of life and be a success. Holistic education at the primary school level leads to better self-governance, higher self-esteem, and overall emotional development.

Other than teaching English, which has almost become a pre-requisite for success in any sphere, teaching basic computing and vocational skills is also necessary. Youth in rural India find it very difficult to compete with their urban counterparts in the job market, and learning vocational skills can help them gain employment.

The project will foster employability enhancement and vocational skills to children in rural areas and work towards their holistic development. In the process, this will also contribute towards fulfilling the growing need for skilled manpower across industry sectors in India.



Medical Support Programme

There is nothing more precious in this world than a child's smile; however, there are many children in India who suffer constant pain and anxiety due to congenital heart diseases and cancer.

Unfortunately approximately 70% of these children are from poor or BPL families, for whom the cost of treating their child is an impossible dream. In numerous cases, CHF has managed to raise funds and save the precious lives of India's future doyens.

During their treatment phase many of these children are unable to attend school. Due to the extended periods of absence from school and the lack of motivation or financial backing, many of them end up as dropouts. And that is how the entire premise of our Swastha Se Shiksha Programme was born. Through our intervention, we ensure that these children are counselled and encouraged to return to school at the earliest in the post-recovery stage.

School Sanitation Support Programme

There is a direct link between the scarcity of toilets and the lack of education. While focussing on providing primary and secondary education ensures that the next generation is far more aware, and can thus mobilise community support in the future (on their own accord) and enhance the wellbeing of their community, providing toilets and clean water is the crux of the solution.

A clean toilet is the biggest motivation for these children to continue their education, thus paving the path for a community that does not have to depend on external help in the future.

Access to clean toilets, soap, potable water, and a simple washbasin and tap can save 300,000 lives across the world every year. Most schools in rural India, lack separate washroom facilities for girls, thereby deterring attendance among adolescent girls. Our primary objective was to increase the number of toilets and provide clean water to schools in rural India by collaborating with our corporate partners.

Orphanage Support Programme

Through our Orphanage Support Programme, Child Help Foundation's goal is to provide care and assistance to those children who have lost their parents' love and support, allowing them to blossom and receive holistic education. Children need consistent and comprehensive care and support to grow and prosper.
