KERELA FLOODS: MDL's HELPING HAND

The State of Kerala was devastated by unprecedented floods in August 2018. MDL extended a helping hand to the flood victims of Pathanamthitta, Alappuzha, Kottayam and Kozhikode districts.

With a view to support the flood affected victims, a team of MDL volunteers was stationed in Kerala for more than two weeks to help in the flood rehabilitation work. MDL's activities started at Kozhikode by distributing 200 cleaning kits to flood victims on 19 August 2018. These kits, consisting of all cleaning gear and cleaning materials, were found very useful by flood victims to clear and clean their flooded houses, when they returned home from relief camps.

Thereafter, the MDL team stationed at Mar Thoma College, Tiruvalla, undertook a massive cleaning operation for over two weeks, with the help of NCC Cadets, NSS volunteers and other local supporters. They were able to clean about 100 Anganwadi Child Development Centres, 14 Schools, 2 Govt rural hospitals, 4 rural health centres and 2 relief camps. All these institutions, in the low lying areas of Pathanamthitta,

Alappuzha and Kottayam districts were heavily flooded and full of slush, mud, slime and waste materials. The Hospitals, Schools & Anganwadis were lying unattended and neglected, as people were busy attending to their own affected houses. MDL team took up the responsibility of cleaning these public institutions and toiled along with cadets and volunteers for more than two weeks to make them functional.

The MDL team found that ration, toys, and mats in Anganwadies and books in Schools were spoiled/ damaged by the flood water. Ration kits (with ration for a month), toys and mats were supplied to about 300 Anganwadies by the MDL team, with the support of other philanthropic agencies. Few damaged Anganwadies were also repaired and repainted. School bags, books, umbrellas and water bottles were supplied to 20 Schools. Rations and relief kits were also supplied to 150 sick and needy people. The MDL team also gave cleaning materials to Trissur and Ernakulam districts. In addition to all these, MDL also presented a cheque to the Chief Minister's Fund.

In line with the Swachh Bharat Mission of Govt of India, MDL has undertaken a massive project in Nandurbar district of Maharashtra on waste management. The project was jointly conceptualized by MDL & District Administration wherein it was decided to transform the way waste management is done in the city through procurement of latest machines & equipment. Under this project, MDL had supplied machines & equipment like vacuum emptier machines, auto tipper, road sweeper machines, drain cleaning machines, mobile toilets etc. to the Municipal Councils for proper waste management.

3 MDL SUPER 10

MDL had commenced a flagship project in the education field titled "MDL Super 10", wherein 10 students from Kharade Gram Panchayat area (Shahpur) would be selected every year for admission to Bhonsala Military School (BMS), Nagpur.

The selected students, belonging to economically weaker section, are getting an opportunity to study at BMS, Nagpur from Std V to Std XII and the entire expenditure towards education of these students at this residential school will be borne by MDL.

The first batch of 10 students were admitted to BMS in academic year 2018-19 and the same number of students would be admitted every year so that meritorious students in the region, who otherwise can't afford quality education, would be able to study in a renowned educational institute like BMS.

4 DRIVERS' TRAINING OF 2000 YOUTHS

MDL has undertaken a mega project of skilling 2000 youths in the driving trade. The project is underway with more than 500 youths already trained. Most of the trained youths have been successfully employed in renowned organizations like Ola, Uber etc. and are able to not only secure a livelihood for themselves but are also supporting their families.

5 MODEL VILLAGE DEVELOPMENT

MDL had adopted Kharade Gram Panchayat in December 2015 to be developed as a model village over three years. Kharade Gram Panchayat of Thane district (Maharashtra) is one of the most backward areas of Shahpur tehsil and it was lagging behind in all the basic development indicators.

In order to improve status of school education, MDL had taken several initiatives including renovation of existing toilets, installation of digital learning set-up in Zila Parishad Schools, distribution of cycles etc. Recently, one Govt school of the village has been ISO certified. There has been special focus on reproductive & child health with regular visits of doctors. Manufacturing of Sanitary pads and Quilts have been operational in the village through Women based Self Help Groups (SHGs) to economically empower the women in the village.

Livelihood generation has also been a focus area under this project and MDL had supported livelihood generation of more than 300 families through different interventions. Goat Farming is one of the key activity wherein goats have been distributed to 200 families along with veterinary support and technical training of families. More than 50 families have been supported through good agriculture practices and 50 families have been trained on Mushroom cultivation.

MDL has also upgraded the village infrastructure by installing 50 solar street lights, laying of drinking water pipelines, setting up of mushroom cultivation centres and other enterprises.

It is indeed heartening to see that the project has made a significant impact in the lives of people in Kharade Gram Panchayat area.
