COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

The Sandvik RAHAT initiative focuses on creating employment opportunities and vocational development for people affected by the landslide and floods in J&K, India. The centre now produces Khadi products and provides women an opportunity to earn, thereby addressing one of the key issues of employment in J&K. The RAHAT initiative will continue to procure, produce and sell Khadi as well as handloom products in future and train women in various entrepreneurial programs.

The Chakan CSR program focuses on creating awareness and access to individual household toilets under Swachh Bharat Campaign, spreading health awareness by organising preventive health check camps and generating livelihoods by providing entrepreneurship training to women.

SKILLS- VOCATIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Under the SANDVIK MACHINIST COURSE every year, 100 marginalized youths are trained in Machinist Course CNC Operator (as per Industrial Training Institute curriculum) and are employed by companies in Pune.
