35000 students have been covered for improving quality of education through various activities/ programmes with guidance from UNICEF. Special emphasis is laid on gender equality through Girl Child Education Programs through awareness campaigns in over 330 schools till date. Bicycles are distributed to students attending schools from distant areas. Several initiatives are undertaken to spread awareness towards education through Anganwadi workers and School teachers training programmes and motivating mothers. Educational tours are organized for thousands of students at industrial units in Kutch to inculcate ideas of thinking big and inspire them to dream of creating world class infrastructure, replicating the vision of the Adani Group. Adani Foundation is also associated with upgrading the existing government Industrial Training Institutes.

Community Health

The Foundation is working towards providing medical assistance through



creating and maintain infrastructure, making available medical practitioners and providing

financial assistance through free medicines, grants and medical awareness campaigns. Successful campaigns have been carried out for Kidney Stone detection and removal for thousands of patients alone in Mundra. Similar medical camps for various other ailments are being held in Tiroda, Shimla, Kawai and Chhindwara. Camps have been organized to detect and provide medical aid for major diseases like HIV/ Aids, Diabetes, Neurological problems, Heart problems, Cancer etc for the members belonging to weaker sections of the society.
