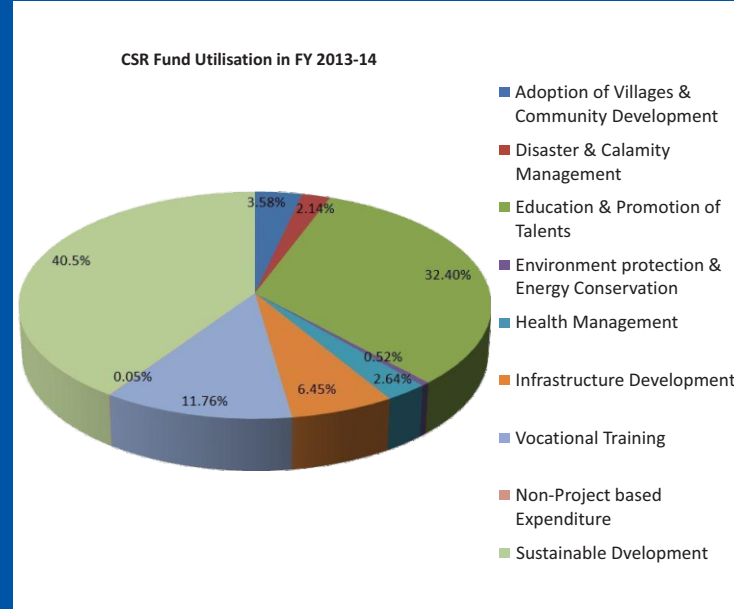


Powering Progress, Brightening lives

BHEL is India's largest engineering and manufacturing company of its kind engaged in the core sectors of the economy, viz. Power, Transmission, Industry, Transportation, Renewable Energy, Oil & Gas and Defence. In recognition of its consistent high performance, BHEL has been conferred with the 'Maharatna' status by the Government of India.

It has been BHEL's endeavour always to act as a responsible corporate citizen committed to working for welfare of the society through inclusive growth aimed at capacity building, empowerment of communities, environment protection, development of backward regions, and upliftment of the marginalized and under-privileged sections of the society. In line with this commitment, the company supports various social initiatives across the country by undertaking projects in diversified areas like Education, Community Development, Health, Environment Enrichment, Vocational Training, Skill Development, Disaster/Calamity Management and Infrastructure Development.



Education:

➤ Providing school education to children of the communities living in the vicinity of its units at Haridwar, Jhansi, Bhopal, Ranipet, RC Puram, Hyderabad and Trichy. At present, the company is running 23 such schools.

➤ Supported a project titled "Katha Reading League in 10 MCD schools" of Delhi which has been implemented by an NGO named "Katha". The project has successfully achieved the objective of rehabilitating slum children, including school drop-outs, developing in them an inclination towards reading/learning through the method of story-telling.

➤ Project titled "Lifting every voice of children" was undertaken by the company to provide quality education to children belonging to under-privileged/weaker economic sections of the society. 300 children have been imparted quality education through 10 integrated learning centres.

➤ Under the programme titled 'Udayan Shalini', 100 brilliant girl children, who have passed class Xth, are being financially supported to pursue their education up to Post-graduation level alongside developing/enhancing their personality and employability.



➤ Partnering with an NGO named 'DISHA' to promote education and skill development of disadvantaged children and youth by imparting non-formal education to 1260 street/slum children including skill training to 240 youth (both boys and girls) living in ten slum clusters



in Delhi.

➤ Supporting a project titled "Education scholarship to mentoring students belonging to BPL category" in partnership with Foundation for Academic Excellence and Access (FAEA). The project involves financial assistance/scholarships to meritorious students, pursuing undergraduate studies in technical and professional disciplines from recognized universities/institutions in the country.

➤ To provide comfortable study environment to children, BHEL donated 50 chairs and desks to the children of Little Angels School, J.J.Colony, New Delhi. These chairs and desks are made out of the waste packing wood of various machineries/equipments.



➤ In association with Ramakrishna Mission supporting a 3-year graded value education program to school teachers from Government, Government-aided and private schools of NCR/Delhi & Bhopal (M.P.). The objective of the program is to create enlightened citizens in schools through transformation of "mindsets"

and "modes of thinking" by encouraging positive mindset, inter-human concern and contribution orientation in school children.

Community Development:

BHEL supported a project called "Anhad Gram" in 25 villages of the backward district of Munger in Bihar with the following four objectives:

- Dairy development, (**Swadhaar**)
- Bio-mass fuel, (**Sulndhan**)
- Women Health & Hygiene, (**SuKanya**)
- Food Processing & Preservation Unit (**SuAahar**)

Swadhaar: The project involves setting up of a milk chilling centre for profitable management of animal husbandry in the villages. Farmers have been trained for proper management of their livestock to ensure better quality and quantity of milk.

Sulndhan: Under the program, briquettes have been produced with a burning efficiency of about 55 minutes, resulting in lesser pollution and better fuel efficiency while cooking. Production of briquettes not only overcome acute shortage of domestic fuel in the villages and in the cities nearby but also act as a dynamic fuel for domestic consumption and commercial usage.

SuKanya: Under this program, a production unit for low cost sanitary napkins in the villages has been set up. The unit, being run and managed by the women self-help groups (SHGs), aims at providing healthy & hygienic living for the village women.

Suaahar: A centre for food processing has been set up in the villages to provide value addition to the crops grown and consequent increase in income of the farmers.



➤ Supported a project to enhance the socio-economic condition of the farmers belonging to tribal community of Khargone district, (M.P.). Under this project, initiatives such as nursery management, crop management including quality enhancement of existing crops, training and awareness program for agriculture techniques, pest management and post harvest efforts have been undertaken.

Health Management:

➤ Committed to providing quality health care services for the needy & deprived people and in particular, for elderly people living in remote/backward regions, BHEL joined hands with HelpAge India, by providing them with 05 Mobile Medical Units (MMUs) for operation in the vicinity of remote project sites of its 04 Power Sector Regions and 01 at IVP Goindwal.



➤ Engaged the services of PHDRDF for operating 03 nos. Mobile Medicare Units (MMUs) in the vicinity of its units at Haridwar, IVP (Goindwal) and Jagdishpur (U.P.).

➤ Extended support to Triumph Foundation, a charitable trust under the Rotary Club of Thane Hills for setting up a Day Care Centre and Blood Bank for patients afflicted with Thalassemia. The Company has funded state-of-the-art equipments for this Blood Bank with modern facilities such as, provision of Nucleic Acid tested blood and blood components at a very nominal cost along with Mobile Van to facilitate voluntary blood donation camps.

➤ Supported a CSR project titled 'Heal a Soul' that involved providing medical assistance to people including children from below-the-poverty line (BPL) families, suffering from Hemophilia.



➤ Partnered with an NGO called "Global Cancer Concern India (GCCCI)" for providing palliative care to terminally ill patients

including cancer patients of Delhi/NCR coming from poor background and with inadequate means of subsistence.

➤ The GCCCI has two full-fledged medical centres at Delhi (Kishangarh) and Gurgaon. These centres are well equipped to carry out palliative care/treatment for cancer patients besides providing free OPD consultations and medicines to the poor and needy people.

➤ Supported an "Orbit and ophthalmic plastics project" in association with Sankar Foundation Eye Hospital, Vishakhapatnam (A.P.) for carrying out 300 orbit surgeries for patients with orbital and lachrymal disorders from the states of Andhra Pradesh, Orissa and Chattisgarh. Under the project, several screening camps have been held for visual acuity and refraction followed by specialist consultation.

➤ Conducted free Eye Camps including cataract surgery for the poor/under-privileged people of Maranda, District Kangra (H.P.). A total of 118 patients were operated for cataract including a few who were afflicted with Glaucoma.



➤ Successfully undertook yet another noble CSR initiative on health by engaging the services of 'Lifeline Express' train, the 'world's first hospital on wheels', to provide free medical treatment to the most needy and poor people of Bundelkhand region. Under the initiative free medical services such as restoration of sight, movement and hearing, correction of cleft lips, dental and neurological treatment etc. to the poor and needy people in nearby villages of Jhansi.

During the period, around 1000 patients have been surgically operated upon for various problems such as polio, cleft lips, post-burn contractual release, eye & ear ailments, epilepsy and dental problems

➤ Extended financial support of Rs.100 lakh to an NGO named "Sane and Enthusiast Volunteers Association of Calcutta" (SEVAC) for construction of a Mental Health Care facility at Thakurpukur, Kolkata. The project involved: (i) a 50-bedded Mental Hospital-cum-rehabilitation centre; (ii) a Day Care Centre; and (iii) an Education Wing Hospital for at least 500 mental patients and their care givers who shall be benefitted every year.



Environment Protection:

➤ A project "Adoption of 15 Villages for Sustainable use of rain water harvesting to enhance livelihood of poor small farmers" in Bijawar block of Chhatarpur district, (M.P.) was undertaken

➤ Another project that entailed afforestation of a barren land (10 acre) was undertaken at Ramadurga in Koppal district of Karnataka. The project involved planting of fruit-bearing trees in a complete patch of barren land and preserving these trees for birds and animals, thereby also promoting protection of species.

➤ A "Navgrah Vatika" was inaugurated on the occasion of Republic Day (26.01.2014) at BHEL Noida Township. Saplings denoting each planet were planted by CMD, Directors and other officials of BHEL thereby promoting conservation of environment.

Vocational Training:

➤ Provided self-employment opportunities to around 500 girls/women and to enable them enhance their social and economic status, programmes viz. "cutting and tailoring" and "beauty culture" for women have been conducted in 6 villages of Jhansi.

Skill Development:

➤ BHEL provides state-of-the-art engineering/training for talent upgradation and training in soft skills to trade apprentices, diploma and engineering degree holders. Apprentices are being trained in various technical trades such as, Machinist, Turner, Fitter, Welder, Plumber, Blacksmith, etc.

➤ Also provided support for setting up an industrial institute at Bolpur, Santiniketan (West Bengal) by the name of Kabiguru Industrial Training Centre (KGITC). The institute achieved 100% employability for the first batch of 42 Fitter apprentices.



Promotion of Art & Culture:

➤ Supported Karnataka Sangeetha Sabha (KSS), for 'Audio Video Aid to the Conference Hall for music education to children' for the Sabha's new building being set up by them in New Delhi.

Infrastructure Development:

➤ BHEL supported "Construction of Tribal Welfare School" at Bhubaneswar Nagar in Assam. The project aims at developing the interest of the tribal children in studies and to augment their artistic skills. The school also takes care of the clothing, food, books and transport for the children.
