### Business and Social Vision of the organization:

Engineers India Limited (EIL) is one of the leading design and engineering organizations in South Asia. Established in 1965, EIL provides engineering consultancy and EPC (Engineering, Procurement & Construction) services principally focused on the oil & gas and petrochemical industries.

The ethos of company's business vision amply vindicate its unflinching commitments towards thorough integration of EIL's CSR policy & Objectives for operating its core business in a socially responsible way, by taking into consideration the wider interests of the community and the environment, with a vision of promoting sustainable development.

Over the years EIL through its robust systems & procedures has been continually demonstrating the ethics of Project implementation mechanism which mandate reconciliation of social, economic and environmental demands – the three pillars of sustainability and thereby setting a benchmark in the arenas of

operation with complete transparency to all stake holders and to the society at large.

The CSR program in EIL aims to assist socially and economically weaker segments of society, building stronger communities and creating a sustainable environment. The CSR mission of EIL have been guided by two elemental ideations, namely, the philosophy of enhancing the educational, health and environmental conditions of the society and towards supplementing/supporting the ongoing and planned initiatives of the local, state or central government with projects / programs being located in and around its work places which includes project sites, regional & branch offices and Head office. The major areas of intervention for CSR projects in EIL that has benefitted the communities at large are education, healthcare, drinking water & sanitation, community development, environment protection & sustainability, rural electrification, women empowerment and upliftment of underprivileged.

### Major Projects

CSR initiatives of EIL entail sustained efforts to raise the quality of life of people from the deprived sections of society. EIL with its CSR initiative focuses on community development and inclusive growth. Major projects undertaken are as under:

### Education

EIL's contribution towards promoting education aims at creating conducive environment for overall development of the local community. One of the major projects undertaken by EIL in the field of education is "School Aapke Dwaar" (Innovation Mobile School) wherein migrant/underprivileged children in the age group of 6 to 18 years living in Gurgaon, Haryana are provided free of cost basic education at their doorstep. This initiative has benefitted more than 300 children.

Other key projects supported or being undertaken by EIL includes construction of classroom and girls toilet; free education to underprivileged children from the slums of Delhi/NCR by providing them formal education, uniforms, books, stationery, meals and facilitation for extracurricular activities; Supporting four units of Gadadhar Abhyudaya Prakalpa (GAP) (two units each at Rahara and Rajarhat-Bishnupur Branch Centre) for holistic development of underprivileged children in Kolkata.



### Healthcare

EIL has been facilitating preventive & curative healthcare facilities to the poor and needy patients belonging to the underprivileged sections of society. To further its commitment, EIL has supported four Mega Medical Camps under 'Jan Swasthya Abhiyan' for benefit of poor and needy community for reducing avoidable blindness in the rural and backward areas. This initiative provided benefit to over 1,000 patients who were provided medicines; over 1,200 patients who were given spectacles and over 200 patients got cataract surgeries done.

EIL also provided medical equipments towards the project "Breaking the barriers of poverty through reduction of disease burden" for serving the underprivileged people residing in slums of Delhi.



### Drinking water and Sanitation

Safe and clean drinking water is essential for the health and wellbeing of all people. Infrastructure creation for safe drinking water provides a long term benefit to the society. Keeping this objective in focus, EIL has set up 20 drinking water filter units in 10 villages each of Kundagol and Kalaghatagi Tuluk, Dharwad District, Karnataka for the benefit of around 9,000 households from underprivileged/backward areas residing there. Apart from this EIL has undertaken several Drinking Water & sanitation projects in the past.



### Rural Electrification

EIL has been working towards addressing the needs of electrification in rural India by undertaking Solar Electrification projects in the rural parts of India. Under this initiative, EIL has installed and commissioned 100 Solar Photovoltaic based LED Street Lighting Systems in various villages of Phoolpur District, UP.



### Women Empowerment

EIL has supported several organizations involved in economic empowerment of women by creating livelihood opportunities. EIL has provided Electrical spiral binding machine, manual paper cutting machine with raw materials, projector, projector screen, student chairs and Mineral RO for underprivileged deaf women.

EIL is also supporting skill training of 49 women inmates of District Jail Gautambudh Nagar at Kasna, Greater Noida in Tailoring, Dress Making and Beautician Trade.



### Skill Development/Vocational Training



EIL has undertaken various CSR projects towards Skill Development and Vocational Training of underprivileged sections of society such as supporting Skill Development Training for 1500 Persons with Disabilities (PwDs) in various trades in various locations in India; supporting employment oriented and skill upgradation training of 40 candidates belonging to SC, ST, OBC and BPL category from Bharuch, Gujarat; has conducted training in dress making and embroidery to underprivileged women & girls in villages around Kota, Rajasthan; livelihood training in cottage industry and basic IT (Information Technology) for around 5,000 women belonging to backward sections of society.

EIL is also supporting for conducting of functional literacy programme for economic empowerment of 120 tribal women of Bolangir District, Odisha and a residential employment oriented training and skill development of 55 candidates in Bharuch

### Environment Protection

Amongst various initiatives undertaken towards Environment Protection, EIL has supported installation of Solar PV Plant of 30KwP capacity in New Delhi for enabling generation of power in a sustainable manner and reduction in carbon dioxide/green house gas emission.



### Upliftment of the Underprivileged

For the benefit of various segments of people from underprivileged section of society, EIL has undertaken various CSR projects especially those related to Infrastructure development. In a major initiative towards upliftment of Persons with Disabilities (PwDs), EIL has supported the organizing of four camps for free of cost distribution of high-tech assistive aids & appliances like Motorized Tricycles, Digital Hearing Aids, Disy Players, Wheel Chairs, Walking Stick, etc. to poor & needy Persons with Disabilities (PwDs), one each at Bhubaneswar, Bolangir & Paradeep Districts of Odisha and Dibrugarh District of Assam.

EIL is also undertaking initiatives for other sub segments of underprivileged sections of society such as Destitute Elderly by supporting 'Multi-Facility Health Package' for cause and care of destitute elderly residing in 12 Old Age Homes located across 5 major States in India.
