Mobile 1000

Mobile 1000 is a pathbreaking initiative of Wockhardt Foundation to provide primary healthcare facilities in Indian villages. Mobile 1000 envisages the setting up of and operating 1,000 mobile medical vans to provide primary healthcare facilities in rural India. It has a doctor, driver and coordinator and is equipped with medicines, healthcare equipments and consumables. It covers the ADCR formula of healthcare delivery i.e. - ‘Awareness, Diagnosis, Cure and Referral’. In 2013-14, 94 lac patients were provided with free medicines.

Khel Khel Mein aims to hone the child's spiritual and emotional quotients which in turn ensures holistic development. These are toy libraries for underprivileged children aged between 6 to 12 years, which provide them with educational toys, books, inculcates them with human values and good habits and teaches civic sense and social skills. Over 63,000 times that students have been benefitted through 14 toy libraries.

Shudhu - Water Purification Tablet is a lasting solution for water purification. It is economical, easy-to-use and effective. One Shudhu tablet can purify up to 20 litres of water in 30 minutes and prevents all communicable water-borne diseases like jaundice, diarrhoea, dysentery, cholera, polio, giardia, among others. More than 11 lac Shudhu tablets have been distributed last year.

Bio-Toilet is a complete waste management solution which reduces solid human waste to biogas and pure water, with the help of a bacterial inoculum. It ensures hygienic and safe sanitation facilities and disposes human waste in a 100% eco-friendly manner. The residual water from Bio-Toilet ensures that waste is rendered colourless, odourless and devoid of any solid particles. The eight installed bio-toilets have been used 1.3 lac times.

E-Learning is designed for students in the age group of 4 to 16 years in rural schools. It includes syllabi based on State Board curriculum in vernacular mediums from 1st to 10th standards across all major subjects. The entire syllabus is accessible in an audio-visual format and is equipped with a child-friendly interface which makes learning a fun-filled and interactive experience. In 2013-14, E-Learning was installed in 43 schools. More than 18 lac times that students have accessed this portal.
