Our port located in Mundra, Gujarat, is the largest port in India and is certified as a green port by IAPH (Indian association of ports & harbors). We are the first company to commission a super critical power plant in India which consumes less fuel and is more eco-friendly. Our power plant in Mundra is also the largest single location thermal plant in the world at 4620 MW and is also one of the greenest power plants in the country.

We live and work in the communities where our operations are based and take our responsibilities to society seriously. We invest 3% of group profit in community initiatives through the Adani Foundation.

The Foundation runs projects in four key areas:

1. **Education** – Quality education and promoting girl child education

## Education

Adani Foundation has been instrumental in providing quality education with its various projects and activities.

The primary focus of our education initiatives is to educate the girl child and improve the quality of education in order to overcome the obstacles that the government encounters on the way to realising its millennium development goals.

Adani Foundation adopts an integrated approach to improve the quality of education in the rural as well as urban areas, with its two pronged approach;

1. Establishing its own school with excellence
2. Support Government Schools - Education is at the forefront of the Foundation's activities as it can be a true catalyst to usher in change not just in an individual but the entire community. It is the key to sustainable development of any society as it not only elevates the present generation to better standards of living but also reflects in subsequent generations.

Highlight of Initiatives

### Programme Support

Improving quality of education in government schools by providing education volunteers, teachers'

training and motivational programs, coaching for dropouts etc.

### Material Support

The Foundation introduced E-learning software at schools, provided reading corners, laboratory equipment, school uniforms & bags, science kits & drawing kits, furniture support, water purification plants with water tanks, bicycles to girls.

### Infrastructure Support

To bridge the gap of available infrastructure in government schools, the Foundation team has improved infrastructure by building schools, adding class rooms, computer rooms, upgradation of sanitation units etc.

### Early Childhood Education

The Foundation runs Balwadis for the labour colony and for fishing community to provide school preparedness programmes and nutrition to children in the age group of 2.5 to 5 years and renders support to Anganwadis too.

### Inspirational Schools

The Foundation has inspired more than 75000 students by organising their visit to Adani Businesses such as port, power plant and edible oil refinery in Mundra.



# Adani Vidya Mandir

Adani Vidya Mandir is an initiative to provide quality education to academically competent children from economically challenged family backgrounds. Under the tutelage of Adani Foundation, the school started functioning in the year 2008 with just three classes. Today, it has reached the zenith of success and has been universally acknowledged for being one of its kind in providing quality education totally free. It is a day boarding CBSE affiliated school, where the students are provided completely free care from morning to evening right from picking them up in the school bus and dropping them back in the evening along with the entire expenses of the day which includes teaching, textbooks and notebooks, three meals, uniforms, mentoring and counselling taken care of.

## Infrastructure

Adani Vidya Mandir, Ahmedabad school is spread over an area of over 26000 sq. mt. with a total built-up area of over 1, 10,000 sq. ft. A rambling campus in picturesque surroundings with lush green lawns and gardens provides a refreshing environment and stimulating intellectual alertness, creativity and unique outlook. The school building has well planned activity centre, multipurpose hall, library, computer lab, science labs, maths lab, seminar halls, sports facilities and play ground. The entire campus has Wi-Fi connectivity.

Highlight of Initiatives

## Community Health

Health for all is the motto of the Adani Foundation. Community health is another core area of focus for the Foundation and an important parameter related to human development index.

Adani Foundation is working towards providing medical assistance by creating and maintaining infrastructure, and staffing them. We also provide financial assistance with free medicines, grants and health awareness campaigns.

The Foundation adopts a holistic approach while addressing key issues and ensures that the most marginalised sections of the society in rural and urban areas are covered under the ambit of health initiatives.

### Mobile Health Care Units

The Foundation operates mobile health care units, rural clinics and organises generic and specialised health camps in far flung rural communities. It extends need based support to government/community/primary health centers located in isolated areas.

### Health Card to Senior Citizens

This innovative project was undertaken as a pilot project for three years after studying the need of Mundra Taluka. Cashless health care is made available free of cost to more than 3500 senior citizens of Mundra Taluka, focusing on prevention and timely health care.

### Kidney Stone Prevention, Early Detection and Care

Successful campaigns have been carried out for kidney stone detection and removal for thousands of patients in Mundra alone. Similar medical camps for various other ailments are being held in Tiroda, Shimla, Kawai and Chhindawara.

### Health Awareness

The community outreach programmes are undertaken by conducting health awareness campaigns to make people aware about their role in the prevention of several diseases and maintaining a healthy lifestyle. This includes awareness of anemia, kidney stone, HIV/AIDS.



# Transforming lives by providing better opportunities



## Sustainable Livelihood Development

The Foundation undertakes sustainable livelihood initiatives for fisherfolk communities, farmers, cattle owners, self help groups, employed youth and widowed women and all other marginalised groups.

It works towards empowering all these people by promoting sustainable livelihoods through participatory, community based approaches, ensuring optimum management of existing resources and broadening the scope of economic opportunities.

The programme aims to improve the bargaining power of weaker and marginalised communities by providing a range of informed choices and livelihood options, facilitate stakeholder consultations, and develop local partnerships to update their skills.

The Foundation invests in building social capital, promoting collective strength through self help groups, supports initiatives towards preserving traditional art and organises skill development training for women artisans.

### Highlight of Initiatives

#### Support to Fisherfolks with Equipment and Amenities

The Foundation extends special support to the fisherfolk communities along the coastal zones of Mundra, Dahej and Hazira by engaging them in various activities. Our support includes providing amenities like sanitation facilities, support schools, approach roads, improved housing, fish sorting sheds, providing equipment such as nets, anchors, cycles, ice box etc. Foundation has a number of programs for propogating and improving educational standards and livelihood opportunities for them.

#### Mangroves Nursery Plantation

As one of the unique endeavors for alternative livelihood during the off season of fishing community, mangroves nursery and plantation have been initiated.

#### Youth Skill Development

Foundation organises regular courses on vocational training to equip the local communities, youth in particular to develop competencies and improve their employability within the Adani group or with the other industries in the vicinity and elsewhere too. It also encourages and supports income generation through individual and groups activities.

## Rural Infrastructure Development

Rural infrastructure development is another important building block on the path towards improving the standard of living of those residing in rural India.

The Foundation believes in investing in the promotion, protection and upgrade of physical capital such as infrastructure and equipment. Adani Foundation's initiative include water conservation and recharge activities such as check dams, deepening of ponds, construction of approach roads, schools, underground drainage facilities with treatment of sewage amongst others.

The Foundation also believes that to make a programme sustainable, effective and replicable, grass root level participation of community members is required and hence all the initiatives revolving around community participation.

It has ensured that the infrastructure development programmes are firmly footed

and responsive to actual needs by undertaking micro planning processes with active community members.

Highlight of Initiatives

### Water Conservation

With an objective of preserving rainwater, reducing the impact of salinity, recharging the ground water and facilitating agricultural activities, several water conservation structures have been constructed with the active involvement of the local community. Pond deepening is assisted by the Foundation to increase the capacity of the village ponds.

### Solar Street Lights

Harnessing the solar power and setting up solar street lights has been seen as an initiative to promote the use of renewable energy technology to meet the energy requirements of the community in a sustainable manner.

### Rural Drainage Project

To create clean and hygienic environment, proper drainage facility is essential. In partnership with WASMO, the Foundation has provided drainage systems in 16 villages including pipeline network and sewage treatment plants at Mundra, Gujarat.

### Other Infrastructure Projects

Under cluster development programme, series of developmental works have been undertaken like building community halls, bus stops, garden and panchvati development, crematorium upgrading, construction of 'gamaan' (cattle shed), rural clinics, entrance gates, cricket grounds, store rooms etc.
