Water Wheel

For privileged few, water comes with the twist of a tap. But for many, access to water requires hard work, hours of walking, waiting in line and heavy lifting. Women walk 4-6 km or more every day to fetch water. And in the dry season, it is not uncommon to walk twice this distance. Collecting water also has its negative impact on health of the women and girls. With the ongoing efforts & initiatives for the social upliftment through its Rural Empowerment projects, Indiabulls Foundation distributed water wheels which provide 45 litres of water per filling and is completely food grade, making it absolutely safe to drink. **The most exciting part about this initiative is that men have taken on the primary role in fetching water, making the women more free to do other household activities.**

We have not only brought relief into these women's lives but also have gone beyond the gender stereotypical image of a man and a woman.

JanSwasthya Kalyan Vahika is a community healthcare project, serving poor at their doorsteps. The van provides primary healthcare services to the underprivileged population through a medically equipped mobile van. These 12 Vans provide free OPD services in preventive, diagnostic, curative health care and distribute free medicines at more than 280 locations on rotational basis. With this program, Indiabulls Foundation caters to and diagnoses approx. 3,75,000 patients per year.



IBF Free Medical Clinic

To strengthen primary healthcare; which includes preventive and curative services ensuring that these services are accessible, physically and financially to weaker sections of society. Qualified medical staff and six days a week operation ensures availability of these services in a timely manner to the local community. Indiabulls Foundation plans to open many such medical clinics in remote and low income areas for the underprivileged.

Cleft Surgeries

Close to 35,000 babies every year are born with cleft or palate deformities. More than half do not receive any treatment as it is more of an economic problem than a medical one. Extending our initiative in this area and partnering with Smile Train, Indiabulls Foundation has sponsored free surgeries of 1800 children suffering from cleft deformities in 6 cities. These surgeries bring back the facial construct of the child to normality and also gives the child a new sense of being and confidence.

Sanitation



Kumud

More than 300 million, women and girls in India do not have access to safe menstrual hygiene products, endangering their health, curtailing their education and putting their livelihoods at risk. Indiabulls Foundation successfully completes yet another year of distributing 'Kumud - Sanitary Napkins' to more than **50,000 rural women & adolescent girls** in Maharashtra from various ashram schools, orphanages, shelter homes and rehabilitation centers. Kumud as a project is not only about distribution of sanitary kits but also is an awareness tool to let the women exhibit their freedom while in menses.

IBF Scholarships



Sponsoring a student's education is the first step in breaking the cycle of poverty for them and their families. Indiabulls Foundation Scholarship Program aims to encourage and promote quality higher education among meritorious students from economically challenged families to nurture their careers. This program is available for students after 12th standard to launch a sustainable career in the field of their choice. In the last three years of the program, Indiabulls Foundation has awarded scholarships to more than 400 deserving students across India.

Rural Empowerment



Rahat

Considering the massive problem of water scarcity in the rural parts of Maharashtra, Indiabulls Foundation has taken up yet another challenging role of providing water to the children of tribal ashram schools in its initiative called Rahat. In this project, such schools are identified where water is a huge problem despite the availability of a water source in the area. Children unfortunately are forced to leave the premises of the school to access these water sources which at times could be kilometres away exposing them to extreme weather conditions and endangering them to wild animals or human traffickers. Indiabulls Foundation, identifies such water sources and provides a pipeline from the source to the school or by creating concrete structures to divert the water flow to the school. Indiabulls Foundation has provided Rahat to 3 tribal ashram schools in the tribal belt of Maharashtra. Approximately 2300 children from these schools benefit from this project every year.



CLABIL project

Indiabulls Foundation has partnered with 'ESHA- People for the Blind' for their CLABIL project - Central Library of Audio Books in Indian Languages. The idea behind audio books was to provide blind students, children in semi-urban and rural schools, older people who lose their sight as they age. The ability to access books with the same ease that people without disabilities enjoy. This effort has since extended its base and reached out to audiences and children at large including groups which have "print disabilities", including blindness and impaired vision. The goal of this partnership is to reach around **10,000 - 12,000 beneficiaries** during the year 2016-17.

Child malnourishment is a major problem in our country and needs to be addressed. India has been able to save children from dying as infants, most of these children survive as unhealthy and disabled population because of malnourishment, which is even more dangerous. At Indiabulls Foundation, we have strived to tackle malnutrition by providing nutrition supplement to more than 76000 malnourished rural and tribal areas of Maharashtra through our Paushtik Aahar - Nutrition Supplement. Paushtik Aahar is made of indigenous cereals, pulses and grains which improves an individual's immune system considerably thus helps in preventing and combating malnutrition.

Renewable Energy



Solar Project

The tribal ashram schools in Maharashtra used to face a lot of blackouts, load shedding and heavy electricity crunch before the start of the project. They had to undergo their daily activities without adequate electricity supply, for many hours, days and even weeks. This initiative of Indiabulls Foundation has seen installation of Solar Power Plants in 5 different tribal ashram schools in Maharashtra. The Solar Power generated will successfully supply 24x7 electricity to the schools attended by more than 4000 children for approximately 25 years absolutely free of cost. This righteous initiative of IBF has not only helped light up the schools but also the students' future.

With torrential rains breaking a 100 year record, the devastating floods in Chennai put the city in grief. Survival became a struggle for the victims as the city became waterlogged, homes were flooded and people started running out of supplies of basic necessities. Indiabulls Foundation deputed its Chennai team for the ground assessment and an in-depth analysis of the affected areas. IBF provided timely relief to 1500 families with 5 kg nutritional packets to each family in the most affected Perumbakkam and Jalladampet villages.
