BRIEF INTRODUCTION OF JAQUAR FOUNDATION & ITS ACTIVITIES

Jaquar Foundation is a division of Jaquar Group, a leader in Complete Bathing Solution, formed with a mission to continuously spearhead CSR related initiatives under Swachchha, Swastha Avam Shikshit Bharat which correspondingly signify Sanitation, Health and Education. Accordingly, Jaquar Foundation has continuously been working in this direction relentlessly PAN India. Few of the activities, being done under the above 3 major areas, are enumerated below.

EDUCATION

We are trying to bridge the gap between the resources required by the Public School vs resources provided by the Government. Accordingly, we have already adopted almost 40 schools in Noida, Gurgaon, Bhiwadi and Delhi having strength of approximately 11000 students to whom **Jaquar Foundation is providing all possible facilities which would enable them to come at par with the Public Schools' education quality.**

One dedicated Skill Development Centre, measuring around 3500 sqft, for imparting Plumbing training is being made at Gurgaon in association with local district administration which will likely be completed by October, 2016

Under Skill Development initiatives, Jaquar Foundation, in association with Govt. organisation and some renowned NPOs like Don Bosco is establishing Skill Development Centres Pan India for Plumbing and allied Trades. We are also in partnership with IPSC (Indian Plumbing Skill Council) who will provide relevant curriculum of different levels of Plumbing Trade followed by assessment and certification to the trainees. With Don Bosco, one such centre is already operational in Bangalore. In addition to it, we are also planning to set up such centres at Ranchi, Rourkela, Guwahati, Cochin, Rajpura, Delhi, Gorakhpur, Lucknow, Kolkata which are under process.

Recently, Jaquar Foundation has entered into an agreement with Skill Development Institute (SDI) which is the society of major Oil companies of India under Petroleum Ministry. In association with SDI, we are making a Plumbing Training Centre at Vizag. SDI is planning to construct 5 Training Centres of International Standards at various locations in India with Jaquar Foundation as Knowledge Partner.

HEALTH

We are already working in this direction to ensure that the health related benefits reach the people who belong to the marginalised society and actually needy persons. These activities are being done by us in association with the reputed NPOs like St Stephen's Hospital Patients Welfare Society, Friends of Sant Parmanand Hospital Welfare Association,

St Stephen's Hospital Patients Welfare Society

Extend our support by adopting 2 beds throughout the year for treatment of disabled patients, eye surgery of children up to 2 years of age and providing artificial limbs to needy patients.

Friends of Sant Parmanand Hospital Welfare Association

For eye surgery through mobile camps and gynae surgery of patients in Himanchal Pradesh as well as free medicines to poor patients.

National Thalassemia Welfare Society

We support by giving regularly medicines (subsidised rates) at 50% cost and infusion pumps to the thalassemia patients free of cost.

To contribute towards Open Defecation Free (ODF) drive, we are constructing seven Public Utility Complexes in Gurgaon out of which two are already operational. Others are at various stages of construction in association with Gurgaon

Immunisation program

In association with District Authorities, Noida, WHO and UNICEF, we supported for their immunisation program which includes 544 HRG (High Risk Group) sites. During this drive, 802 pregnant women and 8680 children (up to 2 years) were immunised.

SANITATION



In adopted schools, modern toilets are constructed / being constructed (approx 50 nos.) which could cater the requirement of more than 15000 students. Few of these are already operational.
